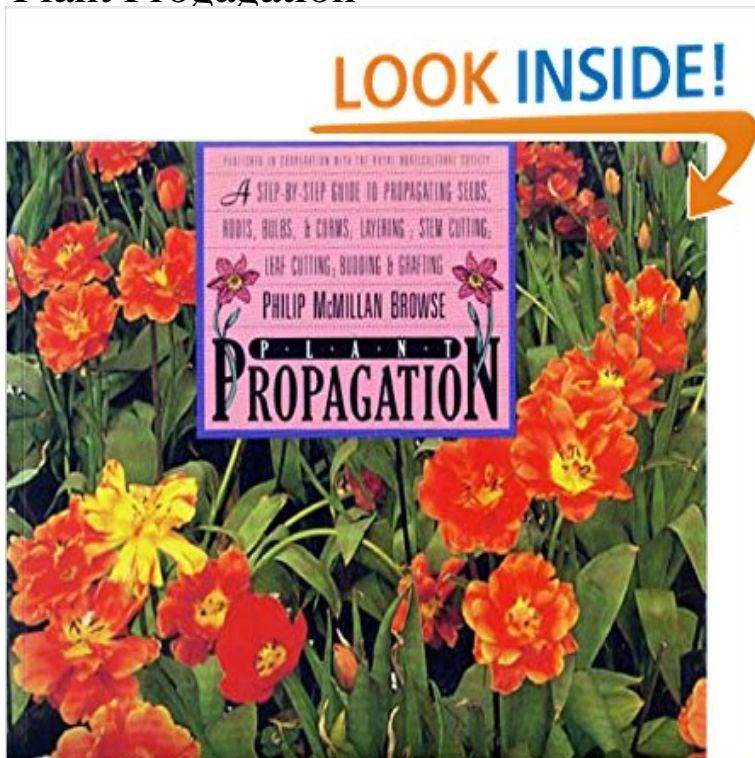


Plant Propagation
