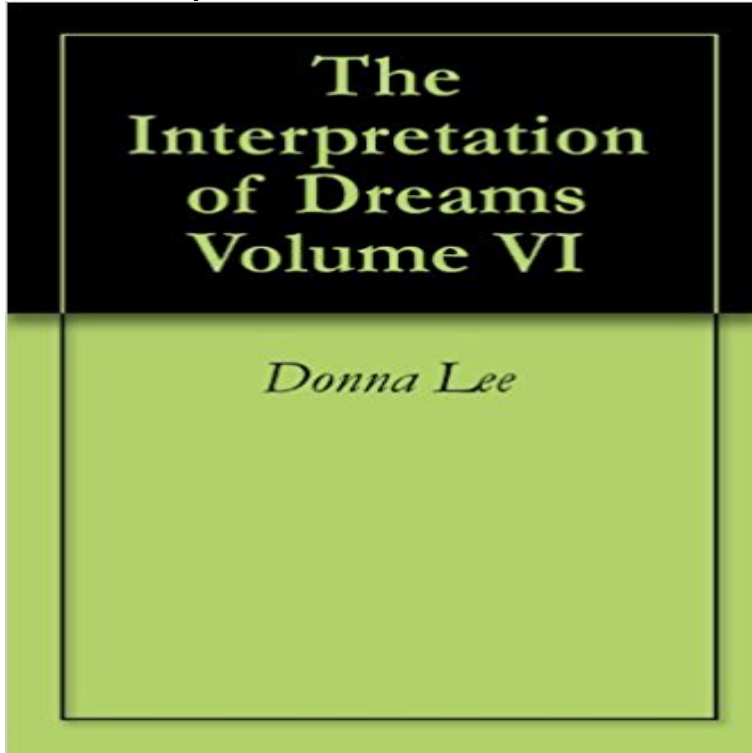


The Interpretation of Dreams Volume VI

What is contained in this book is the sixth installment of my ongoing dream journal! They will be valuable tools to any serious investigator of a life process revealed through a detailed series of dreams. One such practitioner, Aldo Carotenuto, author of the book, The Spiral Way, published in 1986, by Inner City Books in Toronto, Canada, said in his book that, if a skilled analyst were presented with several hundred of a patients dreams, without the associations, sex, age and problems of the patient, he would be able

to draw up a detailed history of the case. (p. 109). There are some associations here and you know some things about me. See how good you are at it otherwise! Most of all, I hope you enjoy what I believe is a unique record for posterity that I have documented here!
