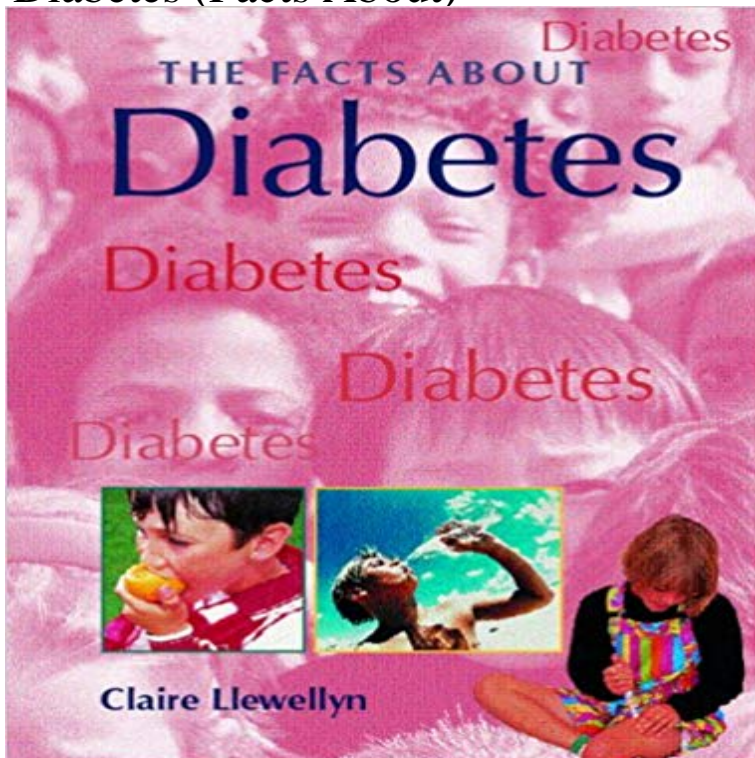


Diabetes (Facts About)
